Respect your environment

The uniform policy is non negotiable and the Academy will not allow our uniform to reflect changing fashion trends.

The academy uniform is both practical and smart and a high standard of uniform is an important feature of academy life. Uniform is important to us as an academy because it allows our students to stand tall, have a sense of pride and self-respect for the way that they present themselves. The uniform also helps to prepare students for work. We notice when people look smart and our students are often praised by members of the public and local community for the way that they look. Our uniform is a clear message to everyone that we care about ourselves and each other. It also promotes equality by requiring all our students to wear the same low-cost uniform, we reduce the incentive for students to ask parents for the latest (and most expensive) items of fashion. As a result, costs are kept as low as possible.

What will not be accepted:

- Unnatural coloured make up such as coloured eyeshadow or lipstick. No false eyelashes or excessive unnatural eyebrow makeup. No false nails.
- Piercings including facial, tongue and body piercings, covering jewellery with a plaster or a retainer will not be accepted.
- Bracelets, rings or hoop earrings. One pair of stud earrings and a watch ONLY. (not a smart watch)
- Baseball caps, hats, non academy jumpers and hoodies are not to be worn on school premises,. This includes PE.
- Only plain black leather, non branded, polishable traditional school shoes are acceptable. Trainers, canvas style fashion footwear or any other inappropriate footwear are not allowed.
- Stretchy, bandage, pleated or pull on skirts.
- Anything other than the academy approved trousers or skirts. Trousers must **not** be tucked into socks and must **not** be skinny, tight, short or tapered fitting.
