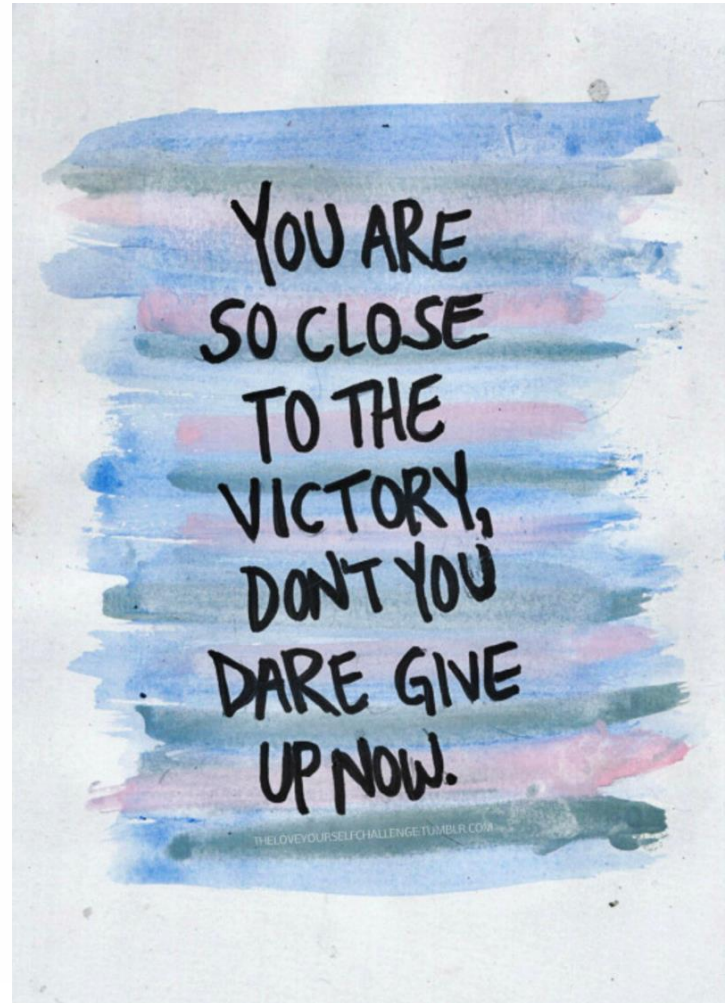

Exam Schedule

- All exam timetables have been sent home and you have a copy (see Miss Allison if you need a new one)
- From Monday 12th May lunch time will change to 12.30pm
- Exam Booster sessions will take place before exams
- You will get a new timetable each week with exam boosters
- Make sure you are revising each evening (ask your teachers what to revise/ QLA's)
- No going home after exams – you will attend booster sessions

Exam Schedule

- Morning exams start after lesson 1, head to exam room at 9.10am
- Afternoon exams 1.30pm
- School opens at 7.30
- Staff support in Year 11 on the morning of an exam
- 8.40 students will go to team rooms (collect a breakfast sandwich/pastry and eat in lesson 1)
- 20 - 30mins exam booster sessions in lesson 1 either live or resources provided by departments.
- Afternoon exams. 1pm go to your teaching room. Teachers to send to Auditorium at 1.10pm
- Toilets must be used before you go to lesson 1
- You must be in school on time for your exam

Exam Schedule

- Enter the sports hall in silence and must stay like this until you are outside and in Y11 area.
- No turning around or having a conversation.
- Toilets cannot be used in the first hour or last 15mins of an exam. Time will be added on to the end if you go out to the toilet.
- You must stay in the exam until the finish time and all papers are collected
- Clear water bottles (no labels)
- No notes in pockets or brought into the exam
- No failing asleep in exams
- Miss an exam and you cannot go to prom

Exam Regulations

- Full school uniform
- The following items cannot be taken into the exam
 - Calculator cases
 - iPods, MP3 Players
 - Electronic communication devices
 - No watches

Exam Regulations

- You must write in Black ink or ball point pen ONLY
- Pencil for diagrams ONLY
- No Tippex, correction fluids or pens (They cannot be used)
- Any attempt to communicate with another pupil will lead to a JCQ investigation and disqualification from the exam
- Respect and follow the Exam Invigilators instructions
- Do not write anything on your paper until you are instructed to do so. It is considered Malpractice if you do
- Sit in the correct seat

Exam Schedule

- Any breaking the rules the school has to inform the JCQ
- This may result in not receiving a grade for that paper or being removed from all other exams
- Do not stop other people getting the results they need, want or are capable of

Illness

- If you are ill and miss a paper you **cannot** sit it at another time
- If you are ill and unable to attend the exam, phone the school first thing in the morning to inform us of your absence
- You will lose the marks for that paper. You do NOT get special consideration

Lateness

- If you think you are going to be late for the start of your exam, please contact the school to inform us
- On arrival at school, you must report to Reception
- If we decide to allow you to take the exam (within 30 mins of start time), a member of staff will escort you to the exam room
- You must not enter the exam room without permission once an exam has started
- Lateness will be reported to the exam board, who will then decide whether to accept your paper for marking
